NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the special regulations of Yachting Australia Inc, the rules of the 125, (Except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

2. ALTERATION OF CLASS RULES

There will be no alterations to Class Rules.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to all 125's

3.2. All Entrants must be holders of a current Yachting Australia Silver/Youth Card.

3.3. Eligible boats will be entered once they have signed on for the day at the South Perth Yacht Club centreboard clubhouse.

3.4. When a competitor has signed on, the competitor then declares the following "I agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of ISAF and by all other rules that govern the regatta and I acknowledge that RRS 4 - Decision to Race, places sole responsibility for a boat deciding to participate in a race or to continue racing as hers alone." The organising authority, its associates and appointees will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death or inconvenience sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

4. FEES

4.1. Regatta entry fee – Nil.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5.1. Competitors Meeting

There will be a welcome followed by a competitors meeting at 0900 on Sunday 13th March 2011, in the South Perth Yacht Club Centreboard Clubhouse.

5.2. Races

The regatta will consist of up to 4 races. The first warning signal for any event will not be made before 0930 on the day of racing. It is intended to have 2 races back to back in the morning and 2 races back to back in the afternoon, at the discretion of the Race Officer.

5.3. Presentation

Presentation will be 1730 in the main club

6. MEASUREMENT

All competing yachts shall conform to the 125 measurement requirements.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

All competitors shall be aware of the hosting clubs sailing instructions (available at www.sopyc.com.au, "The Red Book")

8. REGATTA SITE

The regatta site will be the South of Perth Yacht Club Centreboard Clubhouse.

9. RACING AREA

The racing area will be on the waters of the Swan River known as Melville Water East which are in close proximity to the South Perth Yacht Club.

10. COURSES

The courses shall be a windward – leeward.

11. SCORING

11.1. The Low Point Scoring system, Appendix A.4.1 shall apply.

11.2. The four races shall count to provide an aggregate score, for each competitor.

12. PRIZES

12.1. Cash and Gear prizes will be awarded providing the yacht has competed in a minimum of 3 races.

12.2. Prizes will only be awarded to competitors in attendance at presentation.

12.3. Prizes will be awarded as per “Prizes Attachment”, schedule.
