## NOTICE OF RACE

Annual club event at Rottnest comprising  
Racing for keelboat fleets,  
Escorted Passage sail and  
Non-competitive cruise for power and sail boats.

**1. Rules**

- 1.1. Races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The SoPYC General Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions for 2010-11 shall not apply.

**2. Eligibility**

- 2.1. The event is open to boats registered at SoPYC and keelboats affiliated with a member yachting association, which are invited to participate;

**2.2. Fleets and Safety Categories**

**Racing Fleets A, B, C** - Keelboats complying with YA Special Regulations Part 1, Category 6.

**Escorted Passage Fleet** - Keelboats complying with YA Special Regulations Part 1, Category 7.

**Non-competitive** - Power and cruising yachts not nominating for racing or the escorted passage fleet are invited to make their own way to Rottnest Island for the post-race activities;

**3. Safety Requirements**

- 1.1. Boats shall comply with YA Special Regulations Part 1 for racing boats.
- 1.2. In addition to the requirements of the event category all vessels shall comply with the requirements of the WA Department of Transport for craft proceeding beyond the port of Fremantle which include;
  - Anchor and line
  - Two Way Radio
  - Life Jacket for each person
  - Flares (Inshore and Offshore)
  - Fire Extinguisher/s
  - Recommended – Compass and Chart
- 1.3. Boats shall carry a fully operational 27MHz or VHF marine radio and boats will be required to sign on by radio before starting.

**4. Nomination, Fees and Entry**

- 4.1. Eligible boats may enter by lodging a completed Nomination Form at the On Water Group office, South of Perth Yacht Club by the closing time: 1700, 18th March, 2011.
- 4.2. Boat shall nominate their intended fleet and shall state the YA Category with which the boat complies.

**5. Courses**

The event will be conducted on the Gage Roads area between Fremantle and Rottnest Island and courses will use fixed racing marks.

- Fastest Visiting Yacht Fastest non SoPYC boat in each fleet
- T-Bone Award Best reported misdemeanour
- Navigators Award Most Creative Seamanship
- Biggest Catch Biggest fish or otherwise catch during the race time limit
- Additional awards will be made at the discretion of the race committee
