Introduction

The South of Perth Yacht Club owns an International 420 Class Dinghy which is made available to young sailors as part of a scholarship awarded each year.

As an International Youth Class supported by South of Perth Yacht Club, the Academy believes the 420 is an ideal intermediate class for aspiring yachtsmen and yachtswomen.

The Scholarship

To make effective use of the club's 420 and to provide opportunities to youth sailors South of Perth Yacht Club has established the South of Perth Yacht Club Sailing Academy Youth Scholarship. It will encourage sailors from junior classes to enter the world of high performance, one design sailing, and is open to 2 sailors, 1 skipper and 1 crew. Sailors may apply individually based on their position or alternatively as a team.

Pre-Requisites

The Applicant/s must:

- Be under the age of 17 at December 31, 2009.
- Be committed to the sport and being/becoming a member at SoPYC.
- Complete the application form and submit by the advertised date.

The Package

The Scholarship winners will be awarded:

- 1 fully rigged International 420 Class Yacht for a period of approximately 12 months.
- Access to training programs coordinated and executed by SoPYC.

Commitment

The Scholarship winners must be prepared to undertake the following:

- Compete in SoPYC Summer and Winter racing.
- Compete in International 420 Class Association events as agreed with the SoPYC.
- Maintain the craft to the highest standard.
- Conduct themselves in a fit, professional and sportsman like manner.

- Assume a leadership/role model amongst young sailors at the club and contribute to maintenance programs as requested.
- Undertake a review process with the club at regular intervals.

Parents Commitment

- Maintain the boat.
- Support and encourage their son/daughter in the pursuit of their goals.
- Participate in club activities.

Interview

- Scholarship applicants and their parents may be requested to attend an interview with the Training and Development Committee.

Decision

- The decision of who will be awarded the scholarship will be made by the Training and Development Committee and will be final.
