NOTICE OF RACE

for the races as noted, in conjunction with Flying Fifteen International Western Australia (Inc)

1. DESCRIPTION OF EVENT

A series held over two race days bringing together the Western Australian fleets to remember and celebrate the life of Tally Hobbs who introduced the Flying Fifteen to Australia in 1950.

2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all International Flying Fifteen Class boats whose skipper is a member of FFIWA and a yacht club which is affiliated with YWA.

3.2 Eligible boats must enter by 7 PM, Thursday 11 November 2010 advising boat name, sail number, helm and crew names by e-mail to Peter Mudford, RFBYC FF Fleet Captain -- Email -- muddi057@yahoo.com.au.

3.3 If only sailing at SoPYC, entries containing the above information must be e-mailed to John Hassen, Chairperson, SoPYC FF Section by 7 PM, Thursday, 10 February 2011 --E-mail -- hasman@iinet.net.au.

3.4 Late entries may be received at the discretion of the Fleet Captains and race committee.

4. FEES

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 Warning Signal for race 1 on 14 November 2010 will be 0900. Warning signal for subsequent races will be as soon as practicable after the last boat finishes.

5.2 Warning Signal for race remaining races on 13 February 2011 will be 0900. Warning signal for subsequent races will be as soon as practicable after the last boat finishes.

5.3 Presentation of results will be held at South of Perth Yacht Club following racing on the 13 February 2011

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available from 10 November 2010 from RFBYC and SoPYC or the respective Fleet Captains. They may also be published on the FFIWA website - www.ffiwa.asn.au.

7. VENUE

14 November 2010 – short courses adjacent to the Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club.
13 February 2011 - short courses adjacent to the South of Perth Yacht Club.

8. THE COURSES

Windward/leeward and triangular courses

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rules 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10. SCORING

10.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 8 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

11. PRIZES

Pennants will be presented to Classic, Silver and Open fleets for 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall. The Tally Hobbs Memorial Series' Perpetual Trophy will be presented and engraved with the winners from each division.

12. INSURANCE

Boats shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
