## **1. DESCRIPTION OF EVENT**

This Regatta is a social night series with the aim of providing the Flying Fifteen Fleet with short exciting races, while providing a spectacle to onlookers at South of Perth Yacht Club.

## **2. RULES**

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing ("rules").
- 2.2 The prescriptions of Yachting Australia (YA) will apply.
- 2.3 The rules of the International Flying Fifteen Class will apply.
- 2.4 Rule 40 is altered so that it shall always apply to boats racing and display of flag Y is not required.

## **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International Flying Fifteen Class whose skipper and crew are members of a yacht club which is affiliated with YWA.
- 3.2 Eligible boats must enter by 5 PM, Thursday 3 February 2011 advising boat name, sail number, helm and crew names by e-mail to the Sailing Administrator at [sailingadministrator@sopyc.com.au](mailto:sailingadministrator@sopyc.com.au) Faxed entries and hand delivered to the On Water Group Office at SoPYC entries are also accepted.

## **5 SCHEDULE**

- 5.1 Registration to be complete by 5pm Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> December.
- 5.2 Competitors Meeting – there will be no competitors meeting
- 4.3 Warning Signal for race 1 will be 1655. Races 2 – 3 to follow.
- 4.4 Presentation of results will be at the Centreboard Clubhouse at 1900hrs. The F15 Christmas BBQ will follow, at the Centreboard Clubhouse (b.y.o. food and beverages).

## **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be made available via email distribution with hard copies available in the club main foyer.

## **7. RACING AREA**

The racing area will be on the Swan River adjacent to South of Perth Yacht Club.

## **8. THE COURSES**

Windward/leeward courses are to be sailed as described in the Sailing Instructions. Each race will be 2 laps with a duration of approximately 20 minutes.

## **9. PENALTY SYSTEM**

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## **10. SCORING**

- 10.1 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

## **11 PRIZES**

There will be a presentation of prizes to Classic, Silver and Open fleets for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places, depending upon the number of entries.

**12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**13. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
