NOTICE OF RACE

The organising authority is the South of Perth Yacht Club (Inc.)

DESCRIPTION OF EVENT

This Regatta is a social Friday night series with the aim of providing the Flying Fifteen Fleet with short exciting races, while providing a spectacle to onlookers at South of Perth Yacht Club.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing ("rules").
- 1.2 The prescriptions of Yachting Australia (YA) will apply.
- 1.3 The rules of the International Flying Fifteen Class will apply.
- 1.4 Rule 40 is altered so that it shall always apply to boats racing and display of flag Y is not required.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International Flying Fifteen Class whose skipper and crew are members of a yacht club which is affiliated with YWA.
- 2.2 Eligible boats must enter by 7 PM, Thursday 3 February 2011 advising boat name, sail number, helm and crew names by e-mail to David Tucker-- Email -- David.Tucker@woodside.com.au. Numbers staying for dinner at the Club should also be advised at the same time to assist the Club with its catering arrangements.

3. FEES – Nil

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration to be complete by 7pm Thursday 3 February
- 4.2 Competitors Meeting – there will be no competitors meeting
- 4.3 Warning Signal for race 1 will be 1800hrs. Races 2 – 3 to follow.
- 4.4 Presentation of results will be in the Main Clubhouse at 2000hrs.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be made available via email distribution with hardcopies available at sign on desk.

6. RACING AREA

The racing area will be on the Swan River adjacent to South of Perth Yacht Club.

7. THE COURSES

Windward/leeward courses are to be sailed as described in the Sailing Instructions. Each race will be 2 laps with a duration of approximately 20 minutes.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. SCORING

9.1 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10. PRIZES

There will be a presentation of prizes to Classic, Silver and Open fleets for 1st, 2nd and 3rd and other prizes sponsored by The Gate.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
