



## **Temporary Notice to Mariners**

### **NAVIGATIONAL HAZARD Marine Works Boat Launching Facility Jurien Boat Harbour**

Mariners are advised that marine works to develop the existing boat launching facility in the south east corner of Jurien Boat Harbour are scheduled to commence on 24 October 2011 with an expected completion date around 13 December 2011. Operations will take place Monday to Saturday from 7am to 5pm.

Two new boat ramps will be constructed, one each on either side of the existing ramps with these operations taking place using a land based excavator. **Access to both of the existing boat ramps will remain open at all times.**

Additionally, a universal access pontoon will also be installed using the self propelled barge "Gunna" (13m x 4m x 4.7m) with support vessels in attendance as required. The international code flag "A" will be exhibited during diving activities.

#### **Chart reference DoT Chart WA947 - Jurien Bay**

The above activities will all take place in the works area, which will be delineated by two yellow marker buoys, each approx 1.4m in height and equipped with yellow rhythmic lighting system. Unlit piles will be within the confines of the works area.

All vessels taking part in these works will exhibit shapes and lights in accordance with the Prevention of Collisions at Sea Regulations 1983.

Operators will monitor Marine VHF Channel 4.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when accessing the existing boat ramps in Jurien Boat Harbour during the above works.**
