I have read and understand the Yachting Australia Recommendations on pages 300-302 of the RRS ("Blue Book").

Where the Owner is not the Skipper, I understand that the Skipper is the Owner's Representative for the time that they are in charge of the boat and that I will familiarize them with their responsibilities as stated in RRS 1 and 4 of these Special Regulations.

**Dept. of Transport Exemption:** To avail yourself of the DoT equipment exemption for dinghies leaving the beach whilst at a coastal club, you must be accompanied by a safety boat otherwise you must carry the same equipment as any other boat. The equipment required under the navigable Waters Regulations includes; flares, PFD1, anchor and bilge pump or bucket.
