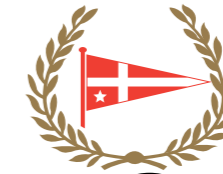

Official salute will be taken from the end of the fuel wharf from the base of the Start Box.

The official party launch, *Summer Salt*, will be moored at the outer end of the Club's main jetty. RC Regatta launch to be moored to north of jetty head/start Box. All other VIP vessels to be located at end of Jetty 3 as per plans.

Yachts are to proceed in single file in a northerly direction, from the assembly area of Martin/Weaver buoys, passing close to the Start Box to take the salute, before proceeding to the starting area, following the route set by the lead yacht.

Skippers are encouraged to dress their yachts and position crew on the gunwale on the saluting side if prevailing weather conditions permit.

Saluting Protocol

Skippers with a formal peaked cap should return the salute. Skippers without formal cap shall return the salute by the placement of the open right hand across the heart.

Supplementary Sailing Instructions

1. Rules

Races will be governed by the Racing rules of Sailing and the Sailing instructions 2011/2012 and as changed by these instructions.

2. All races are designated invitation, but visiting boats are not eligible for the Patron's Trophy.

3. Start

BW8's, S80s and S97s mid-river start with the first warning signal at 1400.

All other fleets handicap start at the Box with the warning signal at 1400.

JAM (Jib and Main) Race for Division Two and H28s.

No course flag will be displayed. Handicap fall numbers will be displayed on the notice board in the main foyer not less than 24 hours before the warning signal.

4. Courses

BW8's, S80s and S97s 2011/2012 Saturday course Appendix D as signalled.

All other fleets boats will start in a northerly direction to Sampson Spit and then continue on the 2011/2012 Saturday Course 4 Short Appendix D for their appropriate fleet.

5. Time Limit

Boats finishing after 1715 will be scored DNF.

6. Trophies

The Patron's Trophy will be awarded to the first boat in any box start handicap fleet that has the biggest difference between her finishing time and the second boat in her fleet.

Pennants will be awarded for the first three boats and fastest times for BW8's, S80s and S97s.
