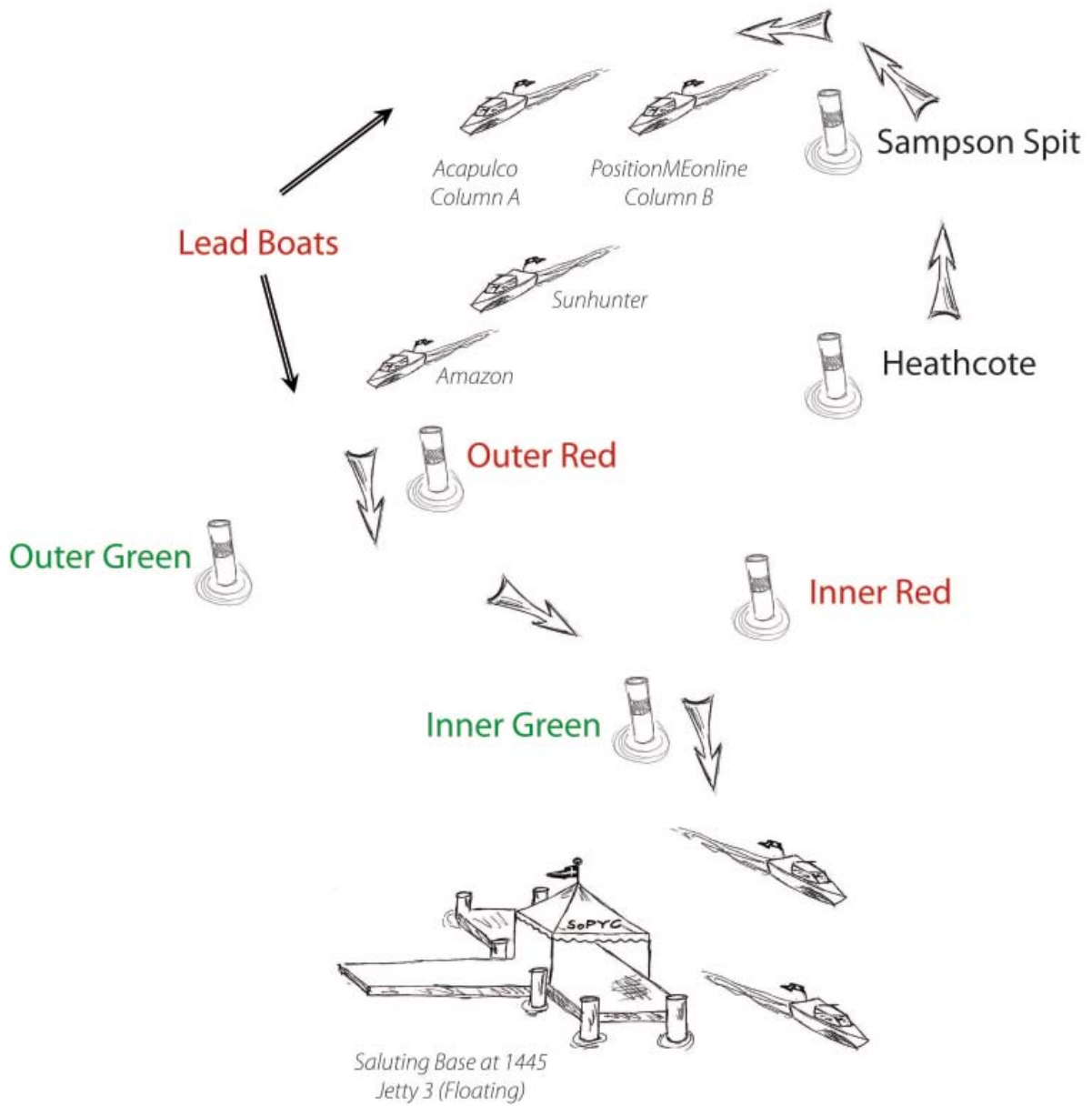

## Order of Events

- 1000      Arrival of Official Guests.
- 1015      Power Yacht members and their guests assemble in the Quarterdeck.
- 1030      Past Commodore Phil Lammonby calls to order for official ceremony.
- 1035      Welcome speech by Commodore Gerry Drysdale.  
Introduction of Past Commodore Roy Richards
- 1040      Opening speech by Past Commodore Roy Richards  
Opening Declaration and Gun is fired.
- 1045      Power Yacht members and guests adjourn to vessels and prepare for sail past. Official guests remain in the Quarterdeck area.
- 1055      Past Commodore requests Official guests to adjourn to Jetty 3 and board VIP Vessels for the Sail Past.
- 1115      Past Commodore Roy Richards and Commodore Gerry Drysdale salute the Sail Past.
- 1130      VIP vessels depart for a sail to watch Time Trial.
- 1145      Opening Day Time Trial - First Power Yacht away

- 1300      VIP Boats return.
- 1330      Official guests and members return to the Ballroom for lunch. During lunch present 50 year gifts.

- 1500      Presentation of Results
- 1515      Tea and Coffee

## Instructions for Sail Past

- 1040 Leave mooring area and proceed to rendezvous north of Sampson Spit. Power yachts should form up in columns as per diagram, behind the lead boats which will be stationary to the west of Sampson Spit. Communication will be via the Marshall Boat on 27.94 MHz.
- 1050 1st Lead boat to head for Outer Red Spit followed by the other vessels at two boat length intervals, with the lead boats, and then all other following as per the diagram.
- 10.55 Columns shall enter Heathcote Channel with the lead boat reaching the saluting base at 1100.
- Vessels in Column "B" should be positioned so they are not obscured by those in Column "A". Boats should be approximately 40 seconds behind the boat in front of them so that there is a boat passing the salute every 20 seconds.
- After saluting vessels are requested to proceed on course for a further 100 metres before leaving formation.
- 1130 Last boat through the sail past.

## General Note

Skippers shall salute the Commodore from the after deck with all crew members seated (with the exception of the helmsman and crew dressing the deck).

Skippers are requested to dress their vessel for this ceremony and endeavour to fly the Australian Flag.

Any instruction given by the Marshall Boats shall be executed promptly. Time Trial shall start at 1145.
