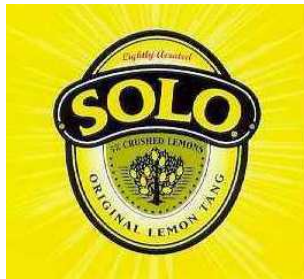

1 DESCRIPTION OF EVENT

Each racing day will represent a regatta.

The series will comprise of five regattas as outlined in the Schedule of Events.

2 RULES

The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing including Appendix A4.1 Low Point System with 2 worst scores excluded if 8 races or more are completed.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The Solo Youth Development Series is open to all the boats of the International 420 Class, International Laser Class (4.7, Radial, Laser), International Optimist Class and Pelican Class whose skipper and crew are members of a yacht club which is affiliated with Yachting Western Australia and Yachting Australia.

In the International 420 Class there will be Silver and Gold fleets. Only skippers who have sailed International 420 class for less than one year, as at 10th of May 2010, will be eligible to compete in Silver fleet.

Eligible boats may enter on the attached Entry Form which shall be lodged with the Race Officer prior to 0900 on the morning their first race in the series.

8 RACING AREA

Races will be on short course adjacent to the South of Perth Yacht Club.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

10 PRIZES

After each regatta there will be a presentation of pennants to Open and Youth (U19 as of 10th May, 2010) in all fleets for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. At the end of the series major prizes will be awarded to Youth in all fleets based on combined results of each regatta, no regatta shall be excluded.

11 COACHING

Coaching in the 420 and Lasers will be permitted in between racing, Open competitors are also encouraged to assist Youth competitors between racing. Coaching in the Pelican and Optimist's will be permitted during racing without interfering with other competitors.

Declaration

I acknowledge and agree that:

- * My attention has been drawn to the ISAF Fundamental RRS 4 "Decision To Race" which states "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".
- * The entry of the boat and crew is agreed to and accepted by the South of Perth Yacht Club on the basis that the owner/charterer, his/her skipper and crew are individually aware of and conversant with the risks involved in the sport of sailing and that the participation in this event is entirely at the risk of the owner/competitor and his/her skipper and crew
- * The owner/charterer warrants the suitability of his/her boat for the event.
- * The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/charterer who must ensure that the boat is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy, and managed by a crew of sufficient number and experience who are physically fit. The owner/charterer must be satisfied as to the soundness of the hull and all gear. He/she must ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in date and that the crew know where it is kept and how it is to be used.
- * Neither the South of Perth Yacht Club nor its officers, employees nor agents shall be responsible or liable for any loss, damage death or personal injury however caused to the owner/charterer, his/her skipper or crew or their property as a result of their taking part in the series and their related activities, including pre-start and post finish operations and shore activities.
- * Neither the South of Perth Yacht Club nor its officers, employees or agents shall be liable for any costs or expenses that may be incurred as a result of special assistance at sea being arranged for any reason whatsoever.

- * Neither the existence of these conditions, and their use by the event organisers, or the inspection of the boat pursuant to these conditions in any way limits the absolute responsibility of the owner/charter.
- * The crew have been advised by the owner/charterer to satisfy themselves as to the experience of the skipper and the adequacy of the boat, all safely equipment and insurance arrangements.

I declare that:

- * The details submitted herewith are correct and any changes that alter the details submitted herewith will be made in writing to the Race Committee prior to the first race in an event of the series.
- * The boat complies with all local maritime regulations and any alteration to the boat or its equipment that affect the validity of this will render the vessel unable to compete in any events until its compliance is reinstated.
- * I will show each crew member or proposed crew member with a copy of this entry form including a copy of this declaration.
- * I and the crew of the boat shall comply with and be bound by the rules & regulations referred to in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the Red Book 2009/10, SoPYC By Laws and any other Supplementary Instructions issued by the Organizing Authority.
- * The boat and its crew holds adequate insurance and in particular insurance against third party claims at least to the minimum cover of A\$10,000,000 and that such cover will be in force and maintained in full force and effect throughout the series.
