Supplementary Sailing Instructions

1 Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, the SoPYC General Sailing Instructions and these supplementary sailing instructions. If there is a conflict between the General Instructions and these supplementary sailing instructions, these shall prevail.
- 1.2 Spinnakers shall not be used. For this purpose of this rule a spinnaker is defined as any sail set forward of the mast not attached to the forestay at regular intervals or hoisted in a continuous groove device.

2 Briefing

A Pre Race Briefing for skippers will be held at 1330 in Archies Bar located adjacent to the Club's On Water Group Offices.

3 Class Flags

3.1 Class flags will be:

Fleet	Class Flag
Old Gaffers	OGA Association Flag
H28/Timber Yachts/Retro Boats	H28 Flag
Couta Boats	Code Flag B

3.2 Boats shall display their identification flag from the backstay or mainsail leech when racing.

4 The Start

- 4.1 The order of starting will be Old Gaffers, H28/Retro Boats followed by Couta Boats. The warning signal for the first fleet will be 1425.
- 4.2 All starts will be from the box in accordance with GSI 12.3.

5 Racing Area

The racing area will be generally Melville Waters East and West

6 Courses

Courses are listed in Attachment A. The course will be designated by a numeral pennant corresponding to the course number, displayed below the fleet identification flag.

7. Penalties

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty

5. Prizes and Trophies

Pennants will be awarded in each fleet for Fastest and 1st, 2nd and 3rd on handicap. Other prizes and trophies will be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority
