1 RULES

- 1.1 The organising authority is the South of Perth Yacht club (Inc)
- 1.2 The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.3 The SMS handicap rules will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

A boat wishing to display advertising shall notify the organising authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regattas are open to all Sports Boats registered at a Club affiliated with a member yachting association of Yachting Australia with a SMS rating above 0.755.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and returning it by hand or email to either the South of Perth Yacht Club or the South of Perth Yacht Club Sports Boat Chairman Mr P. Dunbar.

4 CLASSIFICATION

Races are classified as Category 7.

5 FEES

There is no entry fee for the regattas. A small voluntary donation may be requested to provide items to the volunteers who assist in running the events.

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of each day is 0900.

7 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid SMS measurement certificate and handicap. Boats that fail to produce a valid certificate or handicap will only be eligible for the Performance based handicap trophies

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 9am on Thursday the 25th November, 2010 at South of Perth Yacht Club and will also be distributed via email to all boats that have registered interest in the regattas.

9 VENUE

The regattas will be hosted by the South of Perth Yacht Club with racing conducted on Melville Water East.

10 THE COURSES

- 10.1 The diagram in Attachment A show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left;
- 10.2 The races are two laps of a Windward – Leeward course with a downwind finish.
- 10.3 The course may be changed by the PRO to match other courses being raced in the same area, any change will be verbal by the PRO to all boats in the fleet, any changes will be done prior to any warning signal.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 The races will be scored by SMS handicap with the scoring in accordance with Low Points System described in Appendix A;
- 11.2 4 races are required to be completed to constitute a series;
- 11.3 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores for that regatta;
- 11.4 When from 6 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score for that regatta.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

Rescue boats will be marked with green over white flag.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 PRIZES

The following prizes will be presented will be presented for each race:

- (a) Pennants for first, second and third on SMS handicap;
- (b) A pennant for first on Performance handicap;
- (c) A fastest pennant;
- (d) An overall trophy for first place on SMS will be presented.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regattas entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
