## *420 TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP*

### **Introduction**

The Academy intends to provide an annual training scholarship for committed young sailors to fast track their development in the 420 class.

As an International Youth Class supported by South of Perth Yacht Club, the Academy believes the 420 is an ideal intermediate class for aspiring yachtsmen and women.

### **The Scholarship**

The 420 Training Scholarship will encourage ambitious sailors from junior classes to enter the world of high performance, one design sailing and create opportunities for international competition.

### **Pre-Requisites**

#### ***The Applicant must:***

- Be under the age of 16 at December 31, 2011
- Be a member of the South of Perth Yacht Club (Inc)
- Be a first year skipper. A first year skipper is defined as someone who has not previously skippered a 420 in a State Championship Regatta.
- Be committed to the sport and the SoPYC
- Complete the application form and submit by the advertised date

### **The Package**

#### ***The Scholarship winner will be awarded:***

- 20 individual coaching sessions of approximately two hour duration to be paid for by SoPYC.
- The time of the coaching session will be agreed between the Scholarship winner and the Coach. At the discretion of the Coach the Scholarship winner may invite a training partner to participate in the coaching program.

- A new set of Quantum sails (Main and Jib) for use during the 12 month Scholarship term. The sails are to be returned to the Club after the 12 month Scholarship term.

**Commitment**

***The Scholarship winner must be prepared to undertake the following:***

- Compete in SoPYC summer and frostbite racing
- Compete in International 420 Class Association events as agreed with the SoPYC
- Participate in SoPYC Sailing Academy Training Programs
- Represent the SoPYC at special events, where selected
- Conduct themselves in a fit, professional and sportsman like manner
- Assume a leadership/role model amongst young sailors at the club and contribute to maintenance programs as requested
- Undertake a review process with the club at regular intervals

**Parents Commitment**

- Support and encourage their son/daughter in the pursuit of their goals
- Participate in club activities

**Interview**

- Scholarship applicants and their parents may be requested to attend an interview with the Training and Development Committee

**Decision**

- The decision of who will be awarded the scholarship will be made by the Training and Development Committee and will be final.
