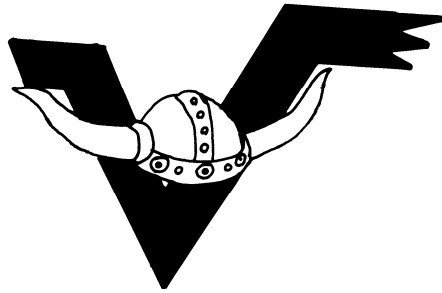

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1 The Organising Authority is South of Perth Yacht Club (Inc.).
- 1.2 Races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.3 Where boats are racing in a class or association fleet, the rules of the relevant class or association will apply.
- 1.4 The SoPYC General and Supplementary Sailing Instructions will apply.

2. Advertising

A boat intending to carry advertising, as provided by Rule 80, shall notify the Organising Authority in writing.

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Viking 30 class.
- 3.2 To be eligible, a boat shall be
 - a) listed on the SoPYC Vessel Register or
 - b) if it is registered at a club affiliated with a Yachting Australia MYA, it may apply to the organizing authority for approval to compete as a visiting boat subject to SoPYC NOR 4.
- 3.3 The designated person in charge of a boat shall be the skipper, who shall helm the boat at all times, unless changed in accordance with the sailing instructions. The skipper shall:
 - a) be a current member of SoPYC in one of the eligible categories as noted in SoPYC NOR 2.5; or.
 - b) comply with the eligibility requirements of a club affiliated with Yachting Australia MYA; and
 - c) be a current member of the Viking 30 Association.

4. Entry and Fees

- 4.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing the Nomination Form and returning it together with payment of \$60.00, to South of Perth Yacht Club before 1700 on 9th March, 2011.
- 4.2 A late entry fee of \$25.00 shall apply to nominations received after 1700 on 9th March, 2011.

5. Category

Races will be classified Category 7 unless otherwise advised.

6. Schedule of Races

7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available approximately 7 days before the event and will be available on the South of Perth Yacht Club website at www.sopyc.com.au

8. Venue

Attachment A shows the location of the racing area.

9. Courses

Races will be conducted on Melville Water East for laid mark windward leeward courses and using fixed marks for club courses as detailed in the sailing instructions.

10. Scoring

10.1 Scoring will be in accordance with the Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A.

10.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When from four to six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races scores excluding her worst score.

10.3 For consistency results, handicaps will be determined by the Viking 30 Association and supplied to competitors with the Sailing Instructions.

11. Berthing

Boats shall be berthed at South of Perth Yacht Club only by prior arrangement.

12. Radio Communication

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

13. Prizes

Results will be announced at South of Perth Yacht Club on Saturday 19th March at approximately 1800 hrs. A trophy will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for the Championship and Consistency at the Viking 30 Association Annual Prize Giving.

14. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 "Decision to Race". The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

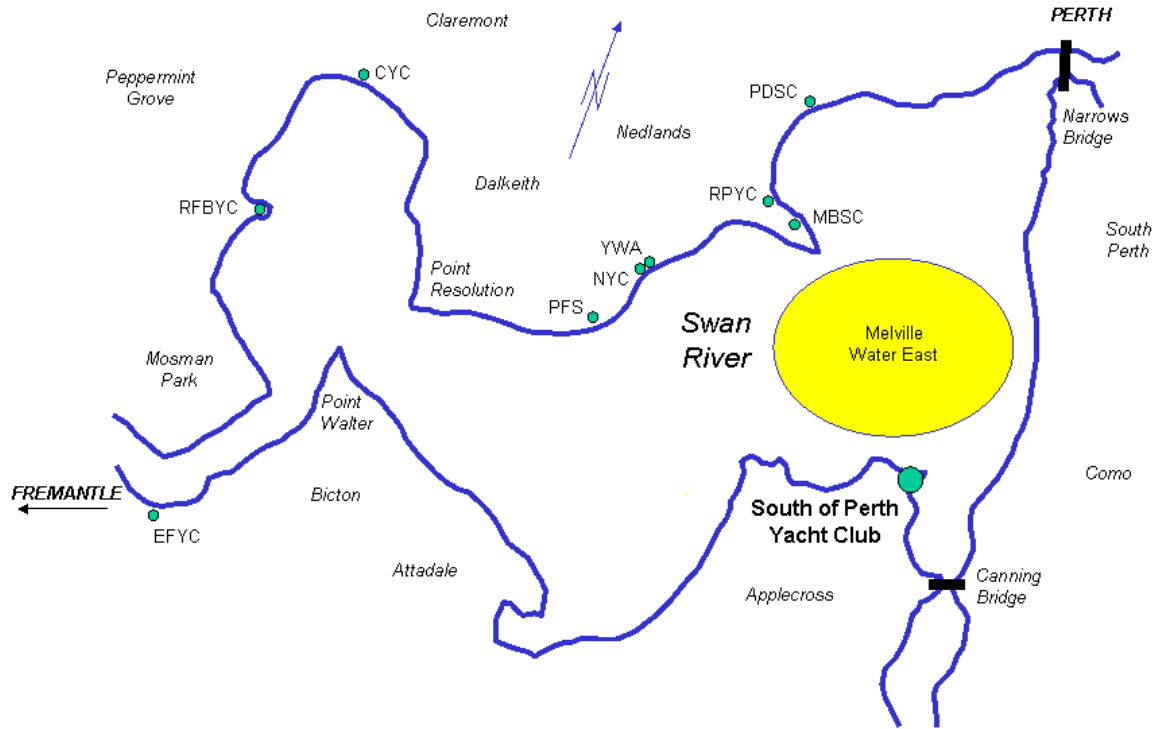
15. Insurance

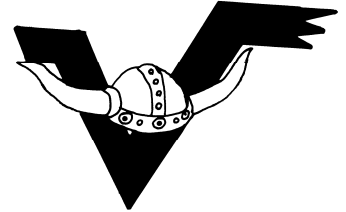
